ENTRY INFORMATION:

Entries must be received by July 4, 2019 with full payment. There are two ways to enter the show:

- Scan and email your entry to jackson.andrea@hotmail.com and pay by email bank transfer, also to jackson.andrea@hotmail.com. No password is required, the account is set for autodeposit.
- Mail your entries with a cheque made out to Andrea Jackson at 726 16 Street NW, Calgary, AB T2N 2C3. N.S.F. checks will result in an additional \$60 service fee. Post-dated checks will not be accepted.

Exhibitors cancelling their entries before the closing date will have all fees less the administration fee refunded. After the closing date of entries but prior Friday July 19 will have the stabling fees refunded, the administration and class fees will not be refunded.

All competitors must enter both days of the show.

2019 AEF membership is mandatory for all competitors, owners and persons responsible. Memberships must be purchased through AEF directly.

A photocopy of the AEF memberships for the Rider, Owner and Person Responsible is required with each entry.

Late entries will be accepted, with a late fee, space permitting.

Hors Concours entries will be accepted with full fees. Entrants are subject to AEF rules and Hors Concours entries are not eligible for ribbons or awards.

COMPETITION INFORMATION:

Alberta Equestrian Federation Wild Rose-sanctioned competitions are to be run in accordance with the AEF Wild Rose Rules. Please refer to <https://www.albertaequestrian.com/wp-content/uploads/2019/02/Wildrose-Rulebook-2019.pdf> for the Wild Rose rules.

Riders must wear approved helmets at all times while riding on show grounds.

Introductory level tests are only open to Junior competitors, competitors may ride in as a Junior until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18.

All tests will be ridden in a 20 x 60 arena.

If a reader is needed competitors MUST provide their own

Each horse/pony is limited to a maximum of four classes per day.

AWARDS:

Class ribbons will be distributed at the show office. Class ribbons will be given to 4th place by category of rider (Amateur, Junior, Open).

Championship award categories will be determined by number of entries, the categories will be announced prior to the start of the show.

STABLING

Stabling fee includes stabling starting at 4 pm Friday July 19 until the close of competition on Sunday. Bedding (shavings) is provided. Please bring your own water buckets as there is no automatic watering system in the barns.

There are no day stalls available at the show grounds.

Please indicate on your entry form if you wish to be stabled with a group and use the same group name on all participants' entry forms.

Stall cleaning deposit: You will receive a refund only if your stall is cleaned down to the dirt and inspected by an organizer prior to leaving the show grounds. You may also donate your stall cleaning fee to the Cochrane Pony Club and they will clean your stall for you, please let show management know if you would like your stall cleaning fee donated.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

Horses will be accepted onto the show grounds on Friday July 19 after 4 pm.

The competition ring will be open for schooling after set up on Friday evening.

Unfortunately space does not allow for a dedicated lunging area. If possible the warmup ring will be closed to riding at certain times to allow for lunging. The lunging schedule will be posted at the show office.

The management committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any errors or make alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. The management committee reserves the right to remove any groom, trainer, owner, manager, or rider from the tournament without compensation. Any acts of discourtesy, or disobedience to the judges or officials by the owner, rider, manager, trainer or groom shall disqualify them from further competition in the tournament and the owner shall forfeit all fees. Inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule will result in immediate disqualification, and forfeiture of the fees. In the case of disqualification, the horse winning the succeeding prize shall receive the prize of the disqualified horse and the other prizes will be adjusted accordingly.

If you can donate some of your time to help out at the show please let us know when you check in. Volunteer opportunities include: whipper-in at the warm up, area test runner, general help.

The Cochrane Ag Grounds are located about 20 minutes northwest of Calgary in the Town of Cochrane.

The grounds are located on the northwest corner of the junction of Hwy's 22 & 1A.

The entrance to the South grounds is located on Hwy 1A - first exit on the right after the highway junction.

COCHRANE & DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY RULES & POLICIES:

1. NO horses through person doors.
2. NO SMOKING in or around barn stabling areas.
3. Water provided in storage tanks is potable. It is intended as drinking water for horses and people. It is not to be used for washing horses. No wash bay facilities are currently available.
4. DO NOT TOUCH BREAKER PANEL BOX.
5. Do not stable or feed your horse(s) in any of the arenas or alleyways. Use stalls only.
6. **NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE STABLING AREA. DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**
